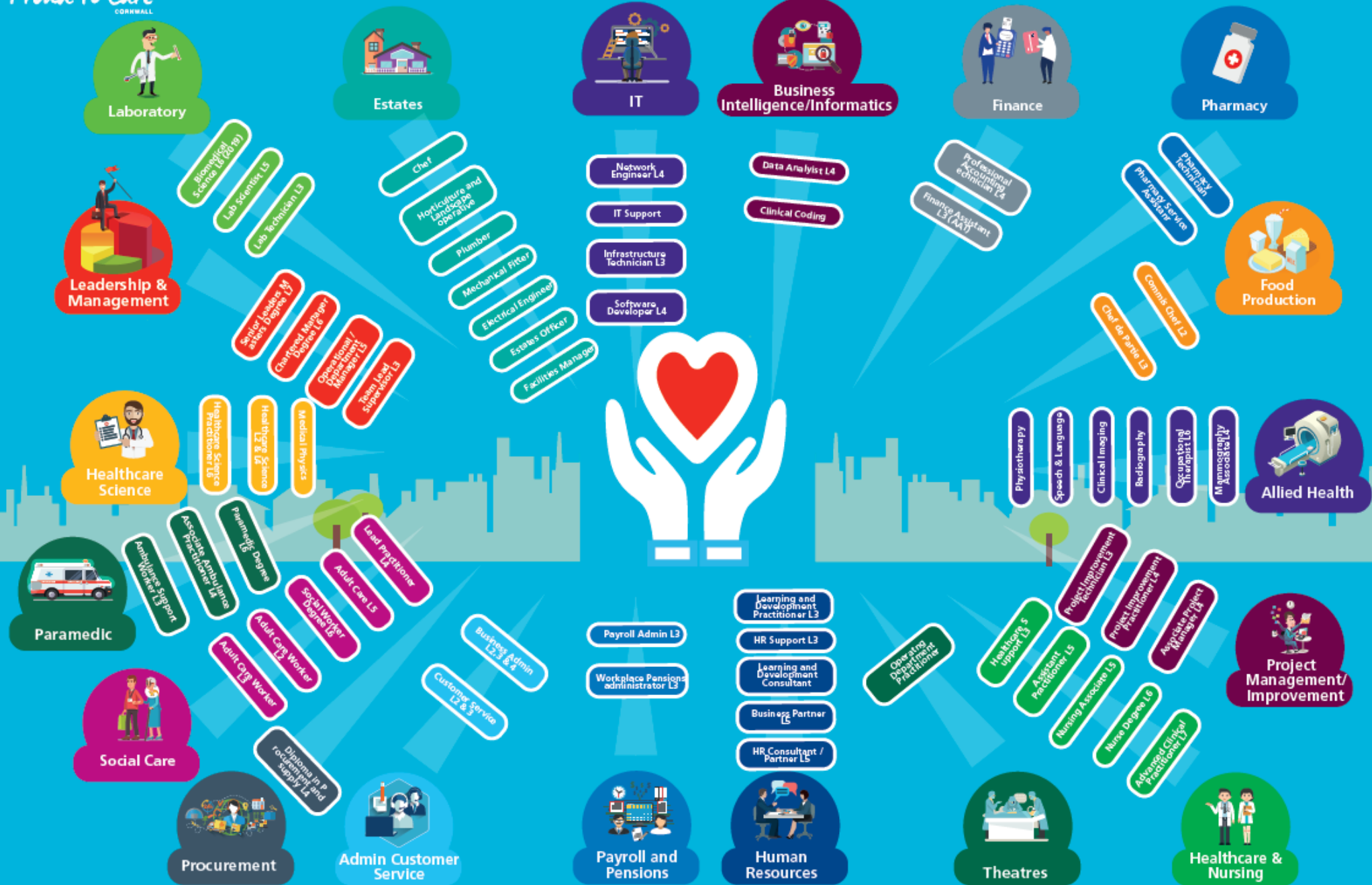

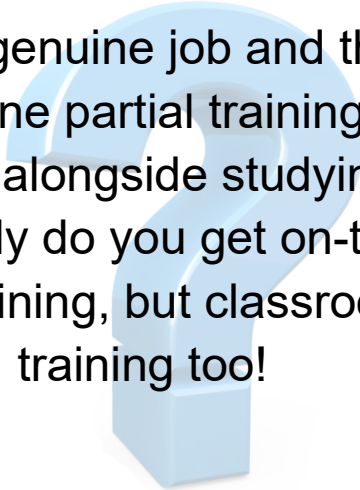

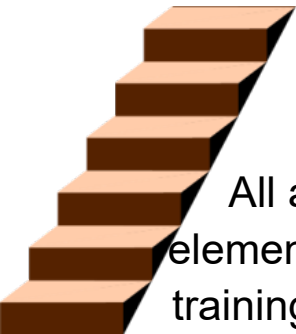


Apprenticeships...

What apprenticeship levels are there?



All apprenticeships include elements of on-and-off the job training which lead to industry recognised standards and qualifications.

Apprenticeships are available from Intermediate Level 2 to Degree at level 6 and 7.

Why become an apprentice?

- It's an opportunity to work alongside experienced staff
- You gain job-specific skills
- Earn a wage and get holiday pay
- You will be given time for study related to your role (equivalent to one day per week)
- Set yourself up for the future!

Entry Requirements

Apprenticeships are available to anyone over the age of 16, living in England, and there is no upper age limit.
